* While three days for Spring Festival holiday duration is statutorily stipulated, it is often the case with public offices and companies, etc. in China that the Spring Festival holidays and National Day holidays are connected with other non-working days, such as Saturday and Sunday, in the vicinity of the statutorily stipulated three-day holidays, in order to make seven consecutive holidays, as shown below in *Official National Holidays and Substitute Business Days in 2021*.
