

		(Beijing-Shanghai). The construction of the Hukun High-speed Railway		
		(Shanghai–Kunming) is underway. The entire line is to be opened in 2015.

		Expressway (Shanghai-Hangzhou), and Shanghai Ring Expressway. The		
		Huxiang Expressway (Shanghai-Nanxiang) was to be opened in August

		construction plan is to make the water depth 15 m and to form the pier		
		with a total extension of 10 km and 30 container berths, which is to be		
		completed in 2020. With those facilities equipped, the port will have
