[Investment Climate]

Geographical and Social Conditions	Henan Province, located in central China, is surrounded by mountains to the south, west, and north. The topography is highly varied, featuring plains, basins, mountains, and hills. The Huang-Huai-Hai Plains spread out to the east. Henan Province borders Hebei, Shanxi, Shaanxi, Hubei, Anhui, and Shandong provinces. It has four seasons, and the temperature reaches 45°C in the summertime.	
Resource Distribution	Henan Province has the largest reserves of cyanite in China. In addition, it has abundant reserves of oil, coal, and natural gas.	
Major Industries	Agriculture, mining (coal)	
Infrastructure	Rail	The Jingguang Railway (Beijing–Guangzhou), Longhai Railway (Lianyungang–Lanzhou), and Jingjiu Railway (Beijing–Kowloon), etc. After the opening of the Xuzhou-Lanzhou Railway, an east-west trunk line currently under construction, it is scheduled to join the Jingguang Railway (Beijing–Guangzhou), the main north-south line in Zhengzhou City. The Zhengbian Intercity Railway (Zhengzhou–Kaifeng) and the Zhengzhou-Jiaozuo Intercity Railway are scheduled to open at the end of 2014. Construction is scheduled to begin on the Henan Shangqiu-Hangzhou High-speed Railway at the end of 2014.

	Expressways	The Jinggang'ao Expressway (Beijing–Hong Kong–Macao), Hushan Expressway (Shanghai–Shaanxi), Ningluo Expressway (Nanjing–Luoyang), Jiguan Expressway (Jinan–Guangzhou), etc. Construction on the extension of the Shijiazhuang-Handan section of the Jinggang'ao Expressway (Beijing–Hong Kong–Macao) is scheduled for completion at the end of 2014.		
	Airports	Zhengzhou Xinzheng International Airport, Luoyang Beijiao Airport, Nanyang Jiangying Airport, Shangqiu Airport, Xinyang Minggang Airport, etc. Zhengzhou Xinzheng International Airport is currently in the second phase of construction.		
	Subways	Zhengzhou Metro Line 1 opened in December 2013. Line 2 is currently under construction. The plan is to develop a rail network with a total of 17 lines by 2050 (for a total of 640 km).		
Transportation and Access	Rail	The trip from Zhengzhou to Shanghai is approximately 7 hours (by China Railway High-speed (CRH)). The trip from Zhengzhou to Beijing is approximately 5 hours (by CRH).		
	Air	There are direct flights from Zhengzhou Xinzheng International Airport to Osaka, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Bangkok, and Seoul, etc.

Recent Topics	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> In July 2014, a construction plan for the Zhengwan High-speed Railway (Zhengzhou–Chongqing Wanzhou) was submitted to the National Development and Reform Commission (NDRC). Construction is scheduled to start at the end of 2014. After it opens, the travel time from Zhengzhou to Chongqing Wanzhou will be shortened to 4 hours. The US company Apple is strengthening its sale system in China. By 2016, it will open 10 new direct sales outlets mainly in inland areas such as Chongqing and Zhengzhou, Henan Province. Currently (as of April 2014), preparations are underway to open the Zhengzhou store.
