[Investment Climate]

Geographical and Social Conditions	Shandong Province is located in the coastal region of China. The Shandong Peninsula faces the Yellow Sea and the Bohai Sea and contains the Yellow River Delta. It is endowed with fertile land along the lower reaches of the Yellow River and a mild climate, making it one of China's leading agricultural provinces. The climate is a temperate monsoon climate. The province is known for its connections to Confucius.	
Resource Distribution	The province has abundant oil resources (Shengli oilfield, Zhongyuan oilfield) and produces one-third, by volume, of the crude oil produced in China. The province also has abundant coal resources (Yanzhou coalfield, Tengzhou coalfield).	
Major Industries	Electronics, household electrical appliances, machinery, chemicals, food processing, textiles and apparel, agricultural products, and marine product processing.	
Infrastructure	Railways	The Beijing-Jiujiang section of the Jingjiu Railway (Beijing-Kowloon), Lanyan Railway (Qingdao-Yantai), Jiaoji Railway (Jiaozhou-Jinan), Hanji Line (Handan-Jinan), Jinghu Line (Beijing-Shanghai), etc. The Qingdao-Rongcheng Intercity Railway is scheduled to open at the end of 2014. Construction is scheduled to begin on Qingdao-Lianyungang Railway (Qingdao-Lianyungang) in 2014. In 2015, the plan is to open all lines of the Shanghai-Kunming High-speed Railway (Shanghai-Kunming) and the Hefu High-speed Railway (Hefei-Fuzhou). Once these are open, the travel time from Jinan to Kunming will be greatly shortened from the current 42 hours 15 minutes to approximately 10 hours.
	Expressways	The Jinghu Expressway (Beijing-Shanghai), Jingtai Expressway (the china mainland sections of Beijing-Taipei), Jiguang Expressway (Jinan-Guangzhou), Shenhai Expressway (Shenyang-Haikou), Qingyin Expressway (Qingdao-Yinchuan), Qinglang Expressway (Qingdao-Lanzhou), etc. Under construction are an expressway that connects Jinan and Dongying as well as the Dezhou-Xiajin section of the expressway that connects Dezhou and Shangrao.

	Ports (Marine)	Qingdao Port, Rizhao Port, Yantai Port, Weihai Port, Dongying Port, Weifang Port, etc. Construction of the world's longest undersea tunnel, Bohai Strait Tunnel (Dalian–Yantai), is in the planning stage.		
	Airports	In addition to Jinan Yaoqiang International Airport and Qingdao Liuting International Airport, there are airports in Linyi, Jining, Yantai, and Weihai. Preparations are underway for construction of Jiaodong International Airport. Yantai Penglai International Airport is scheduled to open in December 2014.		
	Subway	The first subway line in Qingdao City is under construction and is scheduled to open in 2015.		
Transportation and Access	Rail	The trip from Jinan to Shanghai is approximately 3.5 hours. The trip from Jinan to Beijing is approximately 1.5 hours.		
	Ship	There is an international ferry to Shimonoseki, Japan.		
	Air	Jinan, Qingdao, and Yantai are international airports. There are regular flights from Jinan to Osaka, from Qingdao to Tokyo, Osaka, Fukuoka, and Nagoya, and from Yantai to Osaka.

In 2015, when all lines of the Shanghai-Kunming High-speed Railway (Shanghai-Kunming) and the Hefu High-speed Railway (Hefei-Fuzhou) are open, the travel time from Jinan to Kunming will be greatly shortened from the current 42 hours 15 minutes to approximately 10 hours. 2. Construction is scheduled to begin on Qingdao-Lianyungang Railway (Qingdao-Lianyungang) in 2014. Once it opens, the travel time from Qingdao to Shanghai will be shortened to 4 hours. 3. In September 2013, the major Chinese real estate developer, Dalian Wanda Group Co., Ltd., announced that it will build “a Chinese version of Hollywood” in Qingdao, Shandong Province. Aiming to become a major center of movie production, they will build 20 movie studios, sound facilities, and an anime production center. The total investment amount is 50 billion RMB, and the facility is scheduled to open in June 2017. 4. LIXIL-Haier Housing Products (Qingdao) Co., Ltd., a joint venture by LIXIL and the Haier Group, built a new plant in Qingdao as a production base for system kitchens and kitchen materials, and the opening ceremony was held on June 7, 2013.
