Geographical and Social Conditions	<p>Jiangxi Province is located on the southern bank of the Yangtze River in the middle reach. The province borders Zhejiang Province and Fujian Province in the east, Guangdong Province in the south, Hunan Province in the west, and Hubei Province and Anhui Province in the north.</p> <p>Jiangxi Province is of a subtropical monsoon climate, and its temperature varies greatly during the year.</p> <p>The province is home to Jingdezhen, a city famous for chinaware.</p>
Resource Distribution	<p>Jiangxi Province is rich in mineral resources. The province is home to 171 types of minerals that have been discovered, among which reserves of 111 types are confirmed. These reserves of 12 types of minerals are the largest in China, while the reserves of 66 types are ranked in the top 10. Rare metals such as gold, silver, copper, tungsten, and uranium are also abundant.</p>
Major Industries	<p>Metallurgy, metal products, fine chemicals, advanced materials, food products, automobiles, aircraft, and precision machinery</p>

Infrastructure	Railways	The area is home to the Jingjiu Railway (Beijing–Jiujiang–Kowloon), Wan'gan Railway (Wuhu–Guixi), Yingxia Railway (Yingtai–Xiamen), and the Wujiu Railway (Wuhan–Jiujiang), etc. The Shanghai–Kunming High-speed Railway (Shanghai–Kunming) opened in September 2014 in the Nanchang–Changsha section. The passenger-dedicated Hangzhou–Changsha High-speed Railway is scheduled to open at the end of 2014.		
	Expressways	The area is home to the Changjiu Expressway (Nanchang–Jiujiang), Ganzhou–Heyuan Expressway, Hukun Expressway (Shanghai–Kunming), and the Liwen Expressway (Liyuan–Wenzhou), etc. The Nanchang–Ningdu and Nanchang–Shangli Expressways are under construction.		
	Ports	The area is home to Jiujiang Port and Nanchang Port, etc. The extension of the Nanchang Port Dongxingang Area is being projected.		
	Airports	In addition to Nanchang Changbei International Airport, the area is served by airports located in Ganzhou, Jingdezhen, Jiujiang, Jinggangshan, and Yichun. Shangrao Sanqingshan Airport is under construction, and the foundation work was completed in August 2014.		
	Subways	Nanchang Metro Line 1, currently under construction, is scheduled to open in 2015. The construction of Line 2 started in 2012, on schedule to start service in 2016. The construction of Line 3 is scheduled to start in March 2015.		
Transportation and Access	Rail	It takes approximately 6 hours from Nanchang to Shanghai, while it takes approximately 12 hours from Nanchang to Beijing.		
	Air	Regular services operate from Nanchang Changbei International Airport to Hong Kong, Taipei, and Seoul.

On September 16, 2014, the Nanchang-Changsha section of the Shanghai–Kunming High-speed Railway started operation, which was Jiangxi Province’s first high-speed railway that made 350 km/h. The opening of the railway shortened Nanchang–Changsha travel time to 1 hour and 40 minutes and Nanchang–Guangzhou travel time to 4 hours.2. In July 2014, the government of Jiangxi Province announced its plan to construct the Nanchang–Ji’an–Ganzhou High-speed Railway, Hefei–Anqing–Jiujiang High-speed Railway, and the Ganzhou–Shenzhen High-speed Railway.
